# RACV ENERGY breakthrough

The RACV Energy Breakthrough is an exciting program designed to provide opportunities for students, teachers, parents and local industry to work together throughout the year to design and construct a vehicle, a machine or innovation in technology that will represent an energy breakthrough.

The program encourages both male and female participants to examine and use the latest technology while considering its impact on the environment and the way people live locally and globally.

It requires a team effort and an across-the-curriculum approach. These groups then bring their vehicles and machines to Maryborough, Victoria in November, for a huge celebration in which they can demonstrate and trial them in action.

### EVENT categories

#### **Human Powered Vehicles (HPV)**

- 3 wheeled, recumbent vehicle
- Powered solely by human power
- Primary Students trial on Holden Track
- Secondary Students trial on RACV Track

#### **Energy Efficient Vehicles (EEVs)**

- Vehicles powered by a combination of at least two energy sources or all electric or all petrol vehicles
- 1 and 2 seat options
- 24 hour trial on the Holden track

#### **Try-athlon**

- HPVs tested in a time trial & obstacle course on RACV Track
- 8 hour trial on Holden Track

#### **Pushcarts**

- Based on the humble billy cart
- Powered solely by students
- Obstacle course, sprint relay, and endurance relay

#### **Innovations in Technology**

#### Challenge 1: Crafty Design

- A water craft operates under its their own power
- Craft must carry a full soft drink can
- Travel the full length of a channel filled with water

#### Challenge 2: Junk Yard

Open to Primary Students only, this new challenge for 2012, will require teams to create a structure that will span a 1.5 m wide water channel within a set time and with a range of materials provided.




Test ride an electric bike (or eBike as they are more commonly referred) for free at RACV Energy Breakthrough Find us near the Memorial Gates, Princes Park (Park Road entrance) on Saturday 22 November.

An eBike is a bicycle with an electric motor that provides power assistance when pedalling. They can be purchased from retailers or an ordinary bicycle may be converted using kits available online or from retail outlets.

RACV will be running eBike trials that depart every half hour. Experienced staff from eBike retailer Dolomiti will conduct the 20 minute tours. All people over the age of 18 who have valid identification will be able to participate, however be sure to sign up early on the day or via email publicpolicyadmin@racv.com.au as there are limited places per tour.

The advantages of eBikes are many - they can replace car trips, extend the distance that can be ridden, help people overcome terrain such as hills, improve physical fitness and assist people recovering from injuries.

resources, workshops and professional development activities to further enhance the development of learning opportunities that are generated through the energy breakthrough.




## Department of Education and Early Childhood Development


